PROCEDURAL

The retiring Mayor, Councillor Eve Butler welcomed the Lord Lieutenant of Gwynedd, the High Sheriff of Gwynedd all Members, staff and guests to the Meeting.

She indicated how proud and honoured she had been to serve as Mayor of the City of Bangor for the second time in her career.

She paid tribute to former Councillors Rhys Taylor and Gwynfor Edwards, those Councillors who had passed away during the last 12 months being Eddie Dogan and Frank Woodcock. She also paid tribute to the former Town Clerk, Mr Gwyn Hughes who had retired during her year of office as well as the Mace Bearer, Mr Abdul Aziz Barazzi. She thanked them for all their work associated during her year of office. She also welcomed the new Councillors Susan Ashworth, Colin King and Mair Rowlands.

The retiring Mayor outlined work that had been carried out by Bangor City Council during the past 12 months which included works at the Pier, the success of the weekly market, City Centre Partnership, Floral Displays, Christmas lights and works at Penrhyn Hall. A special thanks was given to Bryan Collis and TBOBG for all their efforts in bringing together the Carnival and the Christmas Activities. She outlined some of the events that she had attended during the year and thanked everyone for their kind and generous approach given to the Office of Mayor and for the many invitations which were far too numerous to mention.

The Mayor thanked the new Dean Kathy Jones for saying a short prayer before the meeting and expressed the hope that she would enjoy her position in Bangor City.

Finally, Councillor Butler noted the absence of Mrs Sheila Jenkins, who was a Freeman of the City and indeed this week coincided with Mrs Jenkins 100th birthday for which the Council would send their good wishes. She thanked everybody for their attendance this evening and their good wishes over the last 12 months in Office.

01/16 ELECTION OF MAYOR

The Mayor asked for proposals for the election of Mayor for the forthcoming Municipal Year 2016/2017.

The name of Councillor Dewi Williams was proposed and seconded. There were no other names put forward.

RESOLVED : that Councillor Dewi Williams be elected as Mayor for the forthcoming Municipal Year.

The Mayor then retired to change robes.

On return to the Chamber the Proposer and Seconder, invested the Mayor with the Chain of Office, who then read and signed the Declaration of Acceptance of Office of Mayor of the City of Bangor Council in the presence of the Town Clerk, as the Council's Proper Officer who also signed the Declaration.
