A meeting of the Bangor City Council COVID19 Support Grant Committee was held remotely, via Zoom, on the 6th April 12pm the minutes of which are specified below:

Cllr Collings updated the Committee with his work on the Food Share Scheme. The Scheme, established in 2017, receives surplus food from supermarkets and has helped to deliver the food to those in need throughout the pandemic. Warehouse deliveries from Merseyside means that around £3,000 worth of food is distributed in Bangor. The open event on Sunday has seen demand increasing recently. Cllr Collings felt that City Council support has been invaluable, and acknowledged that the Scheme will still be needed post-pandemic. The challenge is to find ways of making the Scheme sustainable in the long-term, and this includes the City Council looking at external financial support opportunities and additional resources.

Christine King also updated the Committee with her work on the Coed Mawr Scheme. The Scheme is also working with supermarkets, with 57 bags prepared last week to help those

Rhoddodd y Cyng Collings ddiweddiariad i'r Pwyllgor ar ei waith gyda'r Cynllun Food Share. Mae'r Cynllun, a sefydlwyd yn 2017, yn derbyn bwyd dros ben o'r archfarchnadoedd ac wedi helpu i ddarparu'r bwyd i'r rheini sydd mewn angen trwy gydol y pandemig. Mae nwyddau warws a ddaw o Lannau Mersi yn golygu fod bwyd gwerth tua £3,000 yn cael ei ddosbarthu ym Mangor. Mae'r digwyddiad agored ar Ddydd Sul wedi gweld mwy o alw yn ddiweddar. Teimlai'r Cyng Collings fod cefnogaeth Cyngor y Ddinas wedi bod yn amhrisiadwy, a roedd yn cydnabod bydd dal angen y Cynllun yn dilyn y pandemig. Yr her yw i ffeindio ffyrdd o wneud y Cynllun yn gynaliadwy yn yr hir-dymor, a mae hyn yn cynnwys Cyngor y Ddinas yn edrych ar gyfleoedd cefnogaeth ariannol allanol ac adnoddau ychwanegol.

Rhoddodd Christine King diweddiariad i'r Pwyllgor hefyd ar ei gwaith gyda Chynllun Coed Mawr. Mae'r Cynllun hefyd yn gweithio gydag

in need. Limitations on the warehouse deliveries from Merseyside means that they cannot accept further food surplus for now. She agreed that Council support has been crucial, that the Scheme also needs to be sustainable in the long-term, and that she is in regular communication with Cllr Collings and others e.g. Cathedral Foodbank to coordinate efforts to help those in need in Bangor.

The Deputy Mayor said that supporting these schemes is a good and proud thing for the City Council to do. Cllr Day suggested that Cllr Collings and Christine King discuss options to combine resources and contacts in order to ensure that both Schemes are on a sustainable footing. Cllr Day also suggested that the City Council explores fundraising opportunities. Although the City Council cannot support the Schemes financially indefinitely, it can provide alternative ways of helping and supporting them. The Committee joined Cllr Roberts in congratulating both individuals on their excellent and tireless work in supporting those in need in Bangor throughout the pandemic.
